EUROPEAN CHORAL ASSOCIATION

Types of events offered in cooperation with and under the label of the European Choral Association

All events promoted by the European Choral Association including those published in this brochure are based on the following principles:

- events for choirs/vocal ensembles and singers, vocal leaders/conductors, creators/composers, educators/teachers and managers, organised by European Choral Association or in partnership are mostly non-competitive. However, there can be competitions for professionals (such as conductors' competitions and composition competitions) or educational offers in relation to competitions, especially if the organisers are members of the Choral Festival Network.
- all events have an educational aspect (which can be a training course, workshops, choir-to-choir concerts, Open Singing or other elements which help participants improve their level of knowledge).
- all events are international, welcoming participants from outside the host country and providing information and activities in English for an important part of the programme.

There are three basic types of events published under the label of the European Choral Association:

1. Cooperation Events of the European Choral Association



These events are designed by European Choral Association and travel between different countries. They have a typical structure which remains the same with some aspects adapted each time. The European Choral Association is involved in the artistic design and the most important decision-making processes and the participation fees include reduced fees for indirect members of the European Choral Association as well as for participants from specific country groups (the European Choral Association's fee system based on a solidarity principle):

- EUROPA CANTAT festival
- Europa Cantat junior
- Leading Voices
- European Youth Choir (fka EuroChoir)
- World Youth Choir
- Workshops in connection with Membership weekends of the European Choral Association
- Activities offered in the frame of specific EU-funded projects such as capacitybuilding workshops, webinars, grant schemes etc.



2. Events under the Label of the European Choral Association



Events for choirs and singers, vocal leaders/ conductors, creators/composers, educators/ teachers and/or choral lovers, with differing and flexible structure and programmes. The artistic programme is developed in partnership with the European Choral Association and the participation fees are based on the European Choral Association system (see above).

3. Events from the International Choral Sector



Different types of international choral events organised by partner organisations or organisations in which the European Choral Association is a member, and which follow the three principles described above. The concept, structure and artistic programme are developed by the local organisers alone and the European Choral Association has no responsibility for the quality of these events.

SWAN

Singing with Additional Needs

The SWAN project (Singing with Additional Needs) draws on best practices taking place in different European countries to include people with additional needs in collective singing. These additional needs may arise due to disabilities and/or physical or psychological health issues. The project takes a holistic approach, recognising the complexity and intersectionality of people's additional needs and the diversity of skills and approaches needed for everyone to be able to enjoy the physical, psychological, social and educational benefits of singing (#BenefitsOfSinging campaign).





The project's objectives are:

- to collect, scale and promote data and best practices in collective singing for people with additional needs
- to facilitate transnational opportunities for collective singing professionals to engage with the best practices of other countries
- to develop and make use of digital tools to support people with additional needs in participating in collective singing and to make knowledge internationally accessible

The project includes such activities as the development of digital tools and a best practices database, sharing research, experimentation with and evaluation of certain best practices, networking and knowledge-sharing (hybrid and physical workshops, round-tables, conferences).

Concrete outputs include:

- Computer scripts and an e-book for singers with visual impairments
- · Reports on research, experimentation and outcomes
- · A guide for conductors leading a choir for cancer patients
- Recordings of project events
- A database of best practices

The project expects to benefit hundreds of amateur and professional singers with additional needs, choral conductors/vocal leaders, (potential) organisers of initiatives, with an ongoing benefit to thousands more with the resources and outputs created in the frame of the project. Additionally, we foresee an increase in the quality of inclusion of people with additional needs in collective singing as well as in the quantity of opportunities.

The SWAN project is coordinated by Norsk Sangerforum (NO), with partners the European Choral Association (DE), Kanker in Beeld (NL) and Sing Ireland (IE). Sing Ireland will also cooperate with the Choral Culture Association (TR). SWAN is co-funded by the European Union.

CHORAL TIES

Cross-border Training on International and European level

Choral TIES, coordinated by the European Choral Association offers Cross-border Training on International and European level for professionals in the field of Collective Singing. In addition to physical, hybrid and online training for choral conductors/vocal leaders and managers, it promotes youth participation and aims to provide training adapted to different needs and possibilities, to train the trainers and other multipliers, and to introduce a new online training tool.





Objectives of Choral TIES include:

- making use of new technology and digital tools for capacity building, relating to the EU's priority of "A Europe fit for Digital Age" & "New Technology"
- strengthening international cooperation in the field of collective singing, especially with EU neighbours relating to the EU's priority of "A stronger Europe in the World" & an "International Dimension"
- contributing to the European Green Deal through online and hybrid training formats and sustainable travel

These objectives will be reached through

- Activities: webinars, hybrid and physical trainings, an international youth network, cross-border workshops and study tours to selected countries
- 2. Tangible project results:
 - guidelines on how to organise training activities
 - the digital training tool "conductors coach" in several languages
 - audiovisual documentation
 - streamed hybrid and online courses
 - disseminated by the partners beyond the project period

The activities will directly benefit hundreds of professionals within the European Union, in other European countries and beyond, and thousands indirectly. As a result we expect to see a higher level among professionals in the field of collective singing and long-term a higher level of choirs, ensembles and events.

Choral TIES is coordinated by the **European Choral Association** (DE) and brings together the partners **Carus-Verlag** (DE), the **Croatian Cultural Association** (HR) and the **Estonian Choral Association** (EE). Some of the activities will be promoted in cooperation with the **International Federation for Choral Music** – IFCM.

EU-FUNDED PROJECTS



In 2024 the European Choral Association submitted an application for the next round of network funding under the EU Creative Europe Programme with the second part of the project IGNITE - IGNiting an Inclusive and sustainable future for collective singing, "IGNITE 2". The project, building on the achievements of the first part, would run from February 2025 to January 2029. The outcome of the application will be known in summer/autumn 2024.

Should the application be successful, the programme of the European Choral Association in 2025 will include additional activities such as workshops, webinars and financial support schemes which will be published on the website of the association in September or October 2024.



The 9th version of the Walter Strauss Choral Conducting Masterclass promises another enriching experience for choral conductors.


